ATTRACT BACKYARD BIRDS WITH THE RIGHT SEEDS

While almost all bird seed may look pretty much the same to you, it doesn't to the birds you're feeding. Knowing what kinds of seeds different birds like can help you attract a variety of fine feathered friends to your feeders.

Consider these popular seed types and the common backyard birds they attract:

Sunflower – Black sunflower seeds attract blue jays, goldfinches, woodpeckers, purple finches, chickadees, titmice and nuthatches. Striped sunflower seeds appeal to chickadees, doves, grosbeaks, northern cardinals, nuthatches, titmice and woodpeckers. Sunflower hearts (also known as "hulled sunflower" and "sunflower chips") attract chickadees, common redpolls, juncos, doves, finches, goldfinches, grosbeaks, nuthatches, pine siskins, titmice and woodpeckers.

Nyjer – These lightweight, tiny seeds are a favorite of goldfinches. Put nyjer seeds in a hanging feeder with tiny holes so the small seeds won't get blown away. Nyjer also attracts redpolls, juncos, doves, indigo bunting and pine siskin.

Safflower – These white seeds are slightly smaller than black sunflower seeds. Because they are bitter, grackles, blue jays, starlings – and squirrels – don't like them. However, they do attract doves, purple finches, chickadees, titmice and downy woodpeckers.

White millet – Good for scattering on the ground, white millet attracts ground feeders such as juncos, sparrows, indigo



buntings, towhees and mourning doves.

Cracked corn – Popular with ground feeders, cracked corn appeals to doves, crows, jays, sparrows, juncos and towhees. Avoid getting finely cracked corn as it's vulnerable to rot and can quickly turn to mush.

When choosing a bird seed mix, pay attention to the ingredients list on the package. Bird seed is required by law to list ingredients in order of content. Some cheaper mixes have filler seeds such as wheat, red milo, red millet or "assorted grain products." Most backyard birds

won't eat those, and your seed mix could end up wasted on the ground.

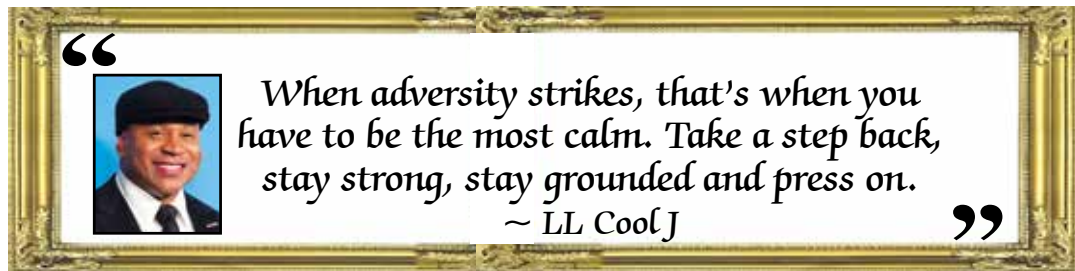

EXPERT TIPS FOR KEEPING LOVED ONES HEALTHY THIS WINTER

Winter can bring plenty of opportunities for cozy gatherings with loved ones and these moments can be bright spots during cold months. However, spending more time indoors means more chances for respiratory viruses to spread.

Flu, COVID-19 and RSV viruses can make people sick enough that they need to go to the doctor or hospital.

“Getting sick from these viruses can happen more often in the winter months,” said Dr. Manisha Patel, chief medical officer of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s (CDC) National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases. “This season’s flu and COVID-19 vaccines, as well as the RSV vaccine, are the best way to avoid serious illness so people can spend time with friends and family.”

How Can You Protect Loved Ones?

Millions of people have already gotten vaccinated this fall or winter. In fact, more people are getting vaccinated for COVID-19 and flu this year compared to this time last year, according to the CDC. Vaccines are the best protection against serious illness. To help keep your loved ones healthy this winter, offer to take them to get vaccinated. Make sure they know it’s safe to get more than one vaccine at the same appointment.

The CDC recommends everyone 6 months and older get flu and COVID-19 vaccines. In addition, everyone 75 and older—and those 60 and older with certain health conditions or who live in nursing

homes—should get one dose of an RSV vaccine if they haven’t before. Pregnant people who are 32 through 36 weeks pregnant during the winter months should get an RSV vaccine to help protect their baby during the first 6 months.

Are Your Loved Ones at High Risk?

According to the CDC, some people face higher risks of getting very sick from respiratory viruses, including:

People not up to date on their vaccines: Vaccines cut your risk of needing hospital care for flu or COVID-19 by about half. In 2023, 90% of adults admitted to the hospital for COVID-19 were not up to date on their COVID-19 vaccines. People who skipped their flu shot were twice as likely to need to visit a doctor for flu.

Older people: Most flu, COVID-19 and RSV hospitalizations and deaths are in people ages 65 and older. If you help care for an older friend or loved one, let them know their risk for getting very sick from these viruses—and that vaccines can help protect them from needing to go to the hospital.

Those who live in long-term care facilities: Respiratory viruses can spread among people in long-term care who may be older or have health conditions that raise their risk of severe flu, COVID-19 and RSV.

Pregnant people: Getting flu and COVID-19 vaccines during pregnancy provides protection against severe illness for you and your baby during their



first 6 months. An RSV vaccine during pregnancy also protects your baby from severe RSV in their first 6 months.

Urge Loved Ones to Get Vaccinated

Flu, COVID-19 and RSV vaccines are the best way for you—and your friends and family—to risk less and do more of what you enjoy this winter.

Additional High-Risk Groups

In the U.S., some additional groups of people are at higher risk of respiratory viruses, according to the CDC.

People in rural parts of the country:

People who live in rural areas face a higher risk of getting very sick from flu, COVID-19 and RSV. In these regions, less than half of adults got a flu vaccine last year. Fewer than 1 in 5 got an updated COVID-19 vaccine. Serious illness can be even more dangerous in rural areas with less available medical care.

Black and Hispanic people: At the peak of last year’s respiratory virus season, Black people were more likely than white or Hispanic people to be hospitalized for flu, COVID-19 or RSV. By season’s end, Hispanic people were more likely than non-Hispanic white people to have been hospitalized for flu. (Family Features)

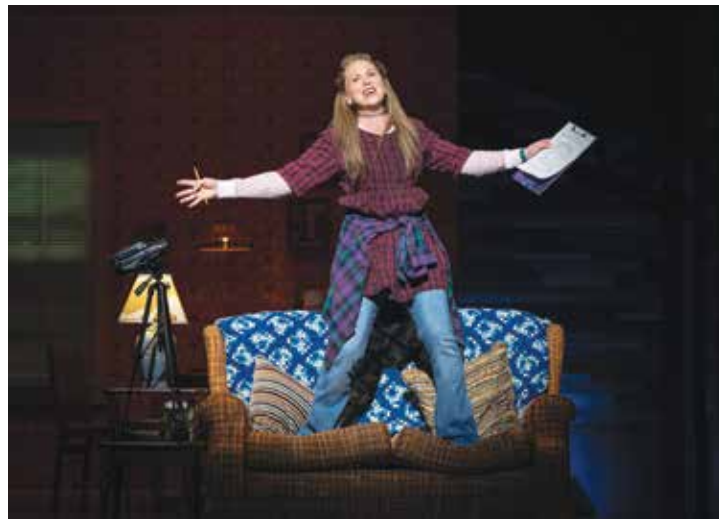

BING CROSBY'S PALM DESERT GOLF ESTATE LISTED FOR \$13.5 MILLION



Bing Crosby was an American singer, actor, and cultural icon whose smooth baritone voice and laid-back charm earned him the title of one of the most influential performers of the 20th century. Born Harry Lillis Crosby in Tacoma, Washington, he grew up in Spokane, where he got his start singing in a high school band. His nickname, "Bing," originated from his childhood love for the comic strip "Bingo from Bingville." Crosby rose to fame in the late 1920s as part of Paul Whiteman's Orchestra and later as a solo artist, becoming a pioneer of the crooning style. His 1942 recording of "White Christmas" remains one of the best-selling singles of all time and continues to receive extensive airplay every Christmas.

Bing's success extended beyond music into film and television. The multi-talented artist was considered America's first multimedia star. He starred in over 70 films, including *Going My Way* (1944), for which he won an Academy Award for Best Actor. His collaborations with Bob Hope in the *Road to...* series showcased his comedic talent. On television, he was a trailblazer, producing some of the first-ever taped broadcasts. Bing died of a heart attack in 1977 after playing a round of golf, his favorite pastime, with

friends in Spain.

The superstar's former home is an elegant residence in Palm Desert's exclusive Ironwood Country Club. Consisting of a five-bedroom main house and three casitas on two-and-a-half landscaped acres, the stunning property has been listed for \$13.5 million.

The home was extensively renovated in 2012, with an eye to preserving the timeless sophistication and attention to detail of the original construction, while adding modern conveniences like solar panels. The classic California design features exposed-beam ceilings, beautiful blonde tile floors, and an airy open-floor plan that connects the living and dining areas with the curated outdoor spaces. The spacious kitchen boasts marble countertops and a center island, while a separate bar with counter seating and wine storage provides a more intimate setting. Some bedrooms include patio access, while others feature marble-clad showers. Of particular interest is the 1,400-square-foot primary suite, which Crosby called "The Kennedy Suite" after JFK and Marilyn Monroe allegedly spent a weekend there together.

Decadent palms and lush lawns surround the compound, which includes



a lighted tennis court and bocce ball court, a full-size pool, and lots of space to entertain, including a covered patio with a built-in fireplace. The Ironwood Country Club includes two 18-hole golf courses, tennis and pickleball courts, and numerous activities ranging from art to cycling.

Palm Desert is a vibrant city within Southern California's Coachella Valley, known for its world-class golfing, top-notch resorts, plus excellent shopping

and dining. It has long been popular with celebrities, with Frank Sinatra, Lucille Ball, Leonardo DiCaprio, and Bing's old comedy partner Bob Hope just a few of the major celebrities who have owned homes in the area.

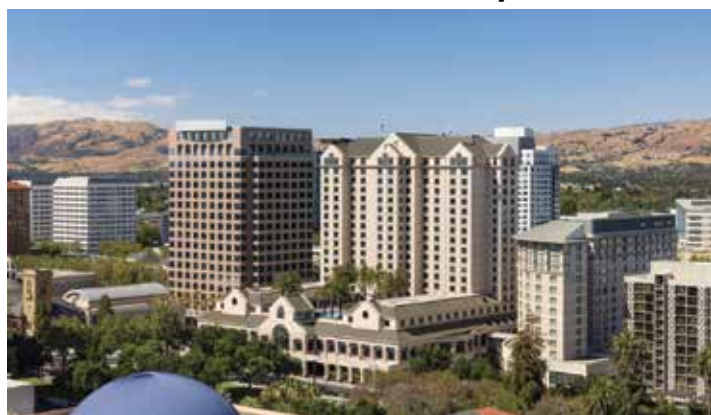

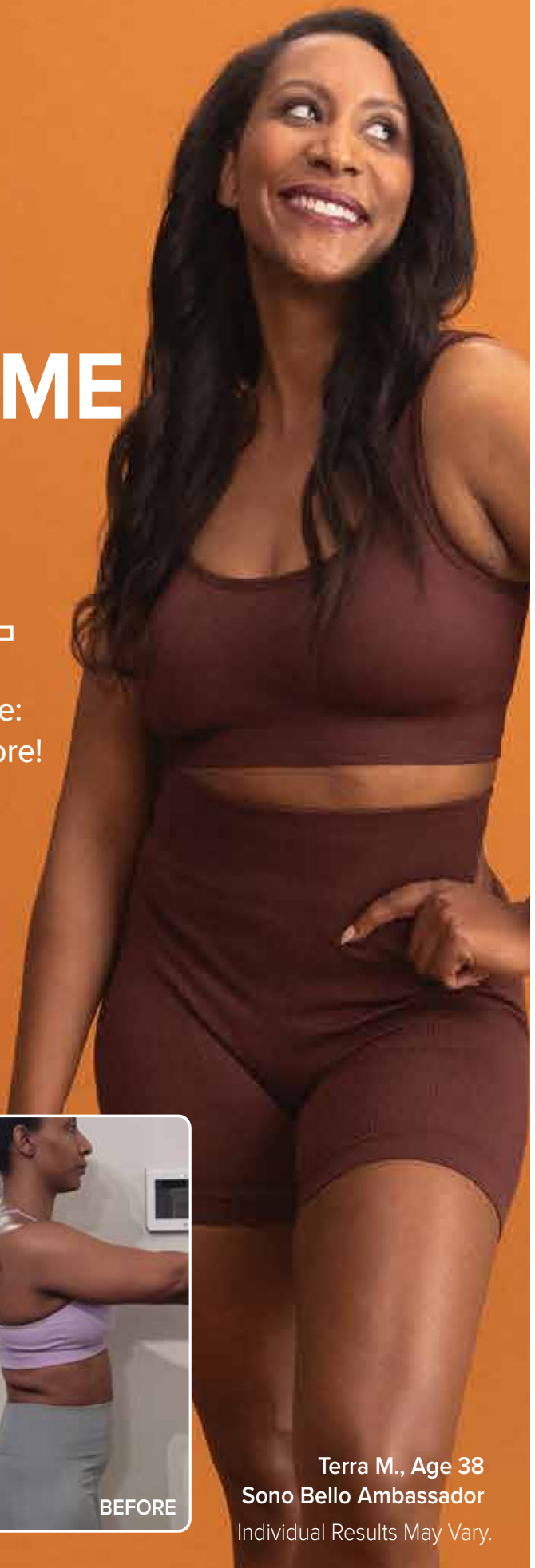
